## Yellow Card/Red Card

Similar to the *Laws of the Game* in soccer, District 5630 will use a system of "yellow cards" and "red cards" to deal with students who break the rules. The host club or District can issue a warning (yellow card) for breaking rules or misbehavior. The student will be given a list of things he/she must do to remove the yellow card. This will also be reported to the student's family and sponsor district. If the student does not comply or receives another yellow card for misbehavior, he/she will receive a red card, which will result in an early return home.

## The following may result in an immediate or an early return:

Breaking of state or federal laws
Possessing and consuming drugs
Possessing and using alcohol
Not attending school
Unauthorized travel
Sexual relationship during exchange
Repeated inappropriate behavior
Refusing to integrate into American society

By signing their application and other documents, Rotary exchange students and their parents have agreed to abide by Rotary District 5630's rules as well as the rules of their host family and host club. They also must abide by the laws of both Nebraska and the United States during their exchange.
